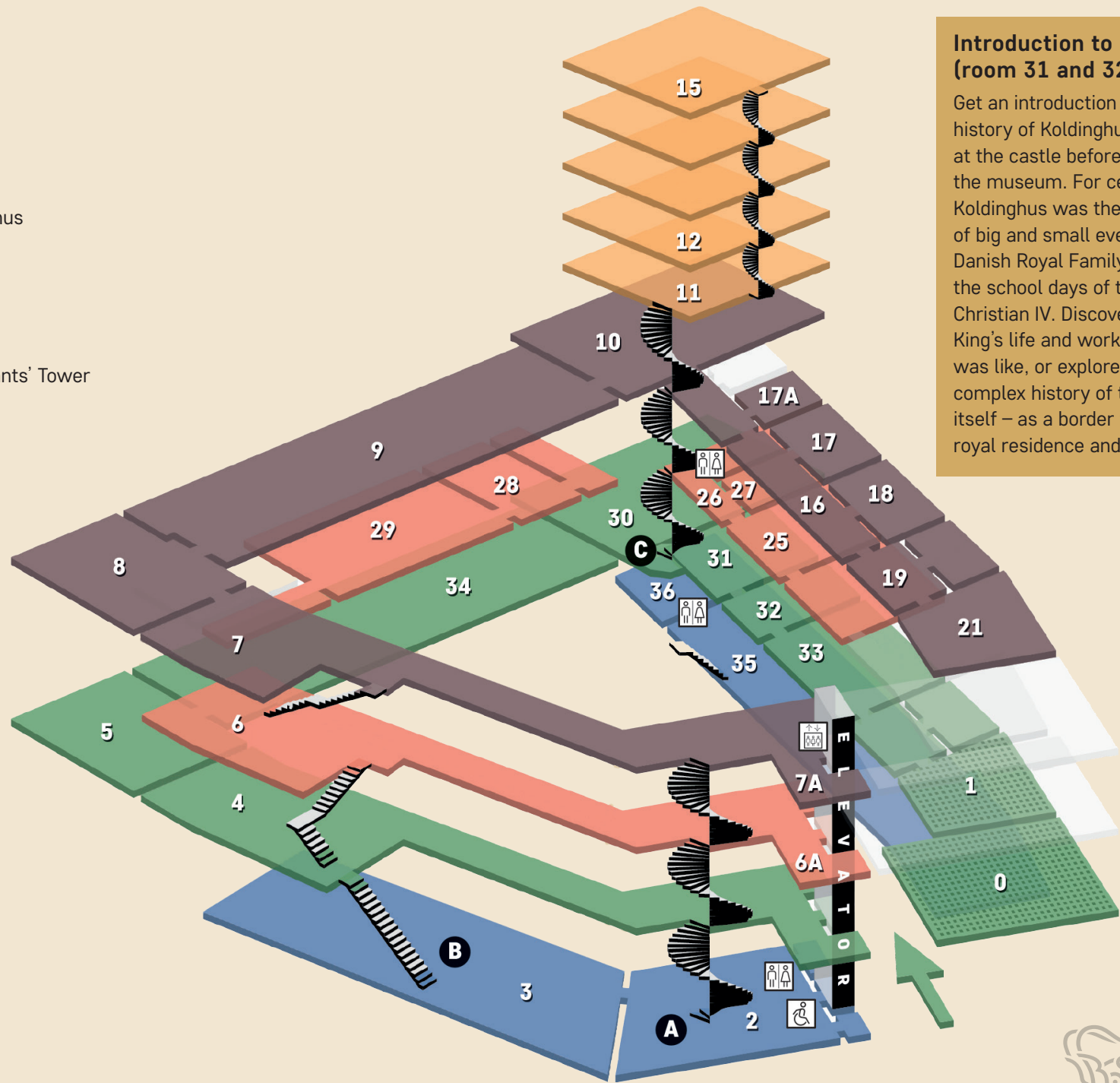

Introduction to Koldinghus (room 31 and 32)

Get an introduction to the history of Koldinghus and life at the castle before you tour the museum.
